SPL Rules:

- 1. Competitor is allowed to use a tone or track of their choice.
- 2. Competitor is allowed to run with driver door or closed, any other window or ventilation gap on or in the vehicle will be seen as an "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and run will be disqualified. The Competitor will be allowed to run again if he/she fixed the "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and have runs left or buys another entry form.
- **3.** Competitors are allowed 3 X "Body Blockers" to assist when running a vehicle. All "body Blockers" must have their feet on the ground at all times, no persons are allowed to sit or stand on vehicle as this will be seen as "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and Competitor will be disqualified
- **4.** If the Vehicle Surpasses the 150 DB Mark the competitor MUST use ear protection or stand outside of vehicle.
- **5.** All + Positive cables must be fused. We strongly advise all cables to be fused at main source to protect you, us and the bystanders. If no Fuse Is used competitor must have a class A/B/C Fire Extinguisher available or competitor will be disqualified.
- **6.** No swapping or changing of sound equipment allowed, in the event of equipment needing to be swapped as result of malfunction or failure it must first be reported to judge and it will be the judge's decision if the competitor will be allowed to do so and run vehicle or if another entry form need to be bought.
- 7. Meter will be placed on Front windscreen by use of template no competitor may move the meter, If there are any issues with placement of meter competitor must inform the judge immediately and not after the run.
- **8.** Only The Competitor who's name is on the entry form are allowed to run the vehicle, only exemption is if the judges permit someone else to run a vehicle (judges discretion)
- **9.** Judges Decision is Final

SPL will be measured at highest peak DB

Bass Boxing Rules:

- 1. Competitor is allowed to use a track of their choice, the full range of vocals must be heard outside of vehicle to bystanders and judge's. If no vocals are heard the judge may disqualify the run if decided to.
- 2. No test tunes (Frequency Generators) allowed in Bass Boxing format.
- 3. Competitor Must run with driver door open, any other window or ventilation gap on or in the vehicle will be seen as an "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and run will be disqualified. The Competitor will be allowed to run again if he/she fixed the "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and have runs left or buys another entry form.
- **4.** Competitors are allowed 3 X "Body Blockers" to assist when running a vehicle. All "body Blockers" must have their feet on the ground at all times, no persons are allowed to sit or stand on vehicle as this will be seen as "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" and Competitor will be disqualified.
- **5.** If the Vehicle Surpasses the 150 DB Mark the competitor MUST use ear protection or stand outside of vehicle.
- **6.** All + Positive cables must be fused. We strongly advise all cables to be fused at main source to protect you, us and the bystanders. If no Fuse Is used competitor must have a class A/B/C Fire Extinguisher available or competitor will be disqualified.
- 7. No swapping or changing of sound equipment allowed, in the event of equipment needing to be swapped as result of malfunction or failure it must first be reported to judge and it will be the judge's decision if the competitor will be allowed to do so and run vehicle or if another entry form need to be bought.
- **8.** Meter will be placed on Front windscreen by use of template no competitor may move the meter, If there are any issues with placement of meter competitor must inform the judge immediately and not after the run.
- **9.** Judge's Decision Is Final.

BASS BOXING will be measured at average DB reading not peak reading



Head-to-Head Challenge

There will be 2 Head-to-Head Categories

- 1. Head-to-Head 1 Target score 135.7
- 2. Head-to-Head 2 Target score 146.8

How it will work two (2) vehicles will play Head-to-Head (at the same time) for 90 seconds bass boxing run (bass boxing rules apply) and the closest to the score limitation in the class will win. If the competitor goes over the limitation they automatically lose. (ex 134.9 -bass boxing average wins VS 136 DB bass boxing average loses in Head-to-Head 1)

General Rules & Info

Cargo area is referred to the area in which you can load cargo /groceries behind the back seat.

A wall build is referred to any subwoofer enclosure that exceeds 750mm in height or that is built from the floor to roof representing a "wall"

"No Wall" is referred to a subwoofer enclosure where the subwoofer/s does not sit higher than the front seats of the car.

Bakkie Cut 2 is a "blow through" system meaning the "cut" section is below the review window

"Stiffening" of body panels is allowed so long it does not interfere with the normal operation of the vehicle as intended by the OEM manufacturer and "stiffening/modifications" is not visible (behind body panels). Competitors are not allowed to reinforce panels with anything other than traditional sound deadening materials available at from car audio dealers and or retailers

All factory/OEM components and panels must remain in their OEM fitted location, only two exceptions are

- 1.Custom door build out to enhance the listening characteristics of the sound system and
- 2. The Advanced and Ultimate classes allow modifications from the B pillar backwards but the cabin has to present the OEM look.

In the event of a "TIE or a DRAW" the judges will look at average scores between all tree runs of both competitors and the decision of the $1^{st}/2^{nd}/3^{rd}$ place will be decided based on the performance of the day.

SPL and Bass Boxing runs are 30 seconds.

SPL is Peak DB. Bass Boxing is average DB score.

A fellow competitor will be allowed to dispute a vehicle if they think the score was cheated or if vehicle was ran "Illegally", in the event of a dispute the person calling for the dispute has to pay R500 to the main judge. When in dispute the judge won't allow the specified person to leave the lane or continue to run the vehicle. The judges will then inspect the specified dispute call (dispute has to be called to a specific part of the vehicle that has been "modified or cheated" to gain an "UNFAIR ADVANTAGE" otherwise the dispute will be ignored) and if found innocent the monies will NOT be refunded. If the competitor is found guilty the competitor will be disqualified and the monies will be refunded to whomever called the dispute.

Max voltage for any system is 16.8V (engine running). Should the judges believe you are over the set limit they will be allowed to test your vehicle for voltage and if found guilty you will be given (one) 1 warning to fix the issue found on vehicle and if issue is not resolved by the time of competing then the competitor will be disqualified

External source units (radios) are allowed.

No Batteries or amplifiers will be allowed to be mounted on outside of vehicle.

External speakers/pods are allowed to be mounted on the outside of vehicle as long as it is mounted properly/securely and doesn't endanger any person/s moving near or around said speaker/pod.

Each competitor has 1 minute from time that meter is placed inside vehicle to start playing or competitor will be disqualified from the run.

All winners of above-mentioned classes will be placed on Fired Up Audio's National Event leader board on website for a specific province and will work on a knock out basis for said province.

Currently Gauteng, Mpumalanga, Northwest, Limpopo, Free State are the provinces that are competing.

Each Province will have at least 2 National Competitions before the year end record Event

Top standing competitors from said provinces to compete at Invite Only Year End National Record Event.

If at year end event the competitor can't attend the next runner up will be put into their place.
